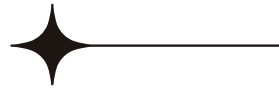




Sudha Murty

Inspired by Virender Sehwag's aggressive batting, she developed a fearless approach to the game. Determined to turn her passion into a profession, she moved to Mumbai to train and refine her cricketing skills under professional coaches. She made her international debut in 2009 against Pakistan in the Women's World Cup and quickly became one of India's most reliable players.



She rose to fame after her breathtaking 171 not out against Australia in the 2017 ICC Women's World Cup semi-final, a knock that changed the perception of women's cricket in India. Her explosive batting, sharp fielding, and calm leadership made her the face of Indian women's cricket. Under her captaincy, India reached the final of the 2020 T20 World Cup, and she later guided the Mumbai Indians Women to victory in the inaugural Women's Premier League (WPL) 2023.

Beyond her individual performances, Harmanpreet has been instrumental in inspiring a new generation of female cricketers. Her journey from a small town in Punjab to the global stage symbolizes determination and self-belief. She often speaks about the importance of discipline, hard work, and mental strength—values that she consistently demonstrates on and off the field.

Early Passion and Sporting Journey

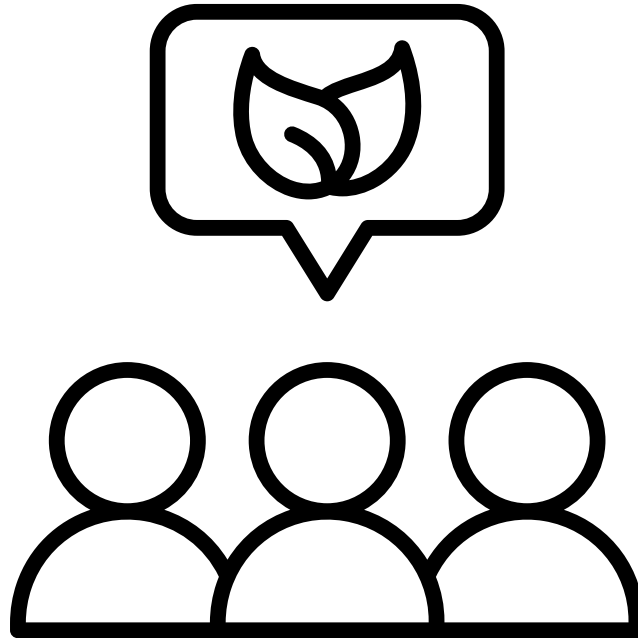

His remarkable record as a **107-time blood donor** reflects not just generosity, but a lifelong discipline to contribute whenever and wherever lives can be saved.

Nidhi Parikh belongs to the second category—an educator, counselor, and edupreneur whose influence reaches far beyond classrooms.

Her journey began early. By ninth grade she was already teaching children in her neighbourhood, shaping skills she would later refine professionally. At 18, she entered the teaching field, carrying the discipline of her father, the empathy of her mother, and a natural instinct for explaining complex ideas with clarity. During her M.Sc. Microbiology days, classmates often turned to her for academic support—proof that her talent was more calling than coincidence.

Her professional rise started in Ahmedabad, first as a lab assistant at Alpha Classes, then as Assistant Biology Teacher and later Science Coordinator at V.R. Shah School. She pushed students toward inquiry-based learning and personally earned recognition by winning the Vikram Sarabhai Science Project Competition twice. A B.Ed. Gold Medal added academic authority to her growing reputation, supported by a strong voice trained through debate victories.

Her expertise expanded when Navneet Publication selected her as E-Author for Biology books for Grades 11 and 12. Encouraged by her family—including her in-laws who recognized her empathy—she stepped into counseling. Research, psychological studies, and a UNESCO certification strengthened her approach. Her work with the Government's Mental Health Department introduced two key models: Teacher Counseling and Guilt-Free Parenting.



As a school administrator at Shree N.K. Academy and a member of Shree Education Trust, she widened her impact through community education. This momentum led to the creation of **ECCI – Educare & Counseling Institute**, built on her core belief: marks never justify knowledge. Through student development programs, parent counseling, teacher training, and social initiatives like NIOS education for women, ECCI has become a powerful human-centred learning platform.

Her dedication earned national and global recognition, including the **Mahatma Gandhi National Award 2025**, and appointments as Permanent Member of both the National and World Human Rights Protection Commissions.

Today, Nidhi Parikh stands as a modern edupreneur shaping balanced, confident learners and empowered parents. She doesn't just teach—she transforms lives.

Twenty Years of Unbroken Fitness

For many, fitness is a phase. For Actor Harshad, it is identity.

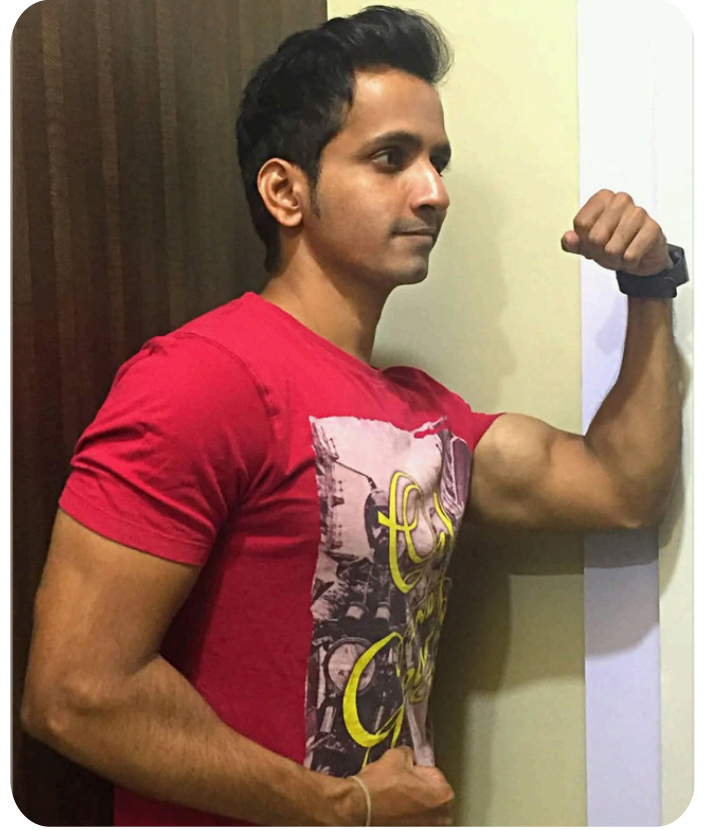
Over the last twenty years, his commitment to physical well-being has remained uninterrupted—across cities, climates, professions, and personal upheavals. From freezing December mornings in Delhi to the humid coastline of Goa, Harshad's routine has followed him everywhere. Belgaum, Mumbai, Pune, Sangli, Karad, Satara, Chiplun, Kolhapur—the geography changed, the discipline didn't.

Unlike many extreme fitness narratives, his approach to food remained grounded. He never demonized meals or eliminated dishes. Awareness replaced restriction. For sixteen years, his weight stayed at 65 kg; over the last four years, he has consciously maintained 70 kg—proof of control, not obsession.

Today, his routine reflects balance and maturity: weight training on one day, a ten-kilometre walk the next. Add to that post-meal walks, deep reading, and regular meditation. This isn't a January resolution or a social media trend—it's a lifestyle refined over time.



Harshad himself calls it a “healthy addiction,” but the truth is simpler: it's discipline practiced daily, quietly, without applause.

As he completes twenty uninterrupted years of fitness, Actor Harshad shares a simple message with the world:

Happy New Year.**

No slogans. No shortcuts. Just consistency—one day at a time.
